4. **Introductions:** President Pepin welcomed and recognized various categories of attendees CMSgts, new members, first time attendees, etc
5. **Presentations:** No awards or special presentations. Division

9 Vice President Jon Bennett gave the oath of office to and installed Kristi Binard as the Division 9 Airmen Activities Coordinator.

6. **Reports:**

- a. **Legislative:** Jim Howard - Briefed and provided handouts of Chapter 985's Legislative monthly report for June 2006
- b. **Activities/Programs:** Jeff James –Nothing new to report.
- c. **Communications:** Tim Ossinger - Still awaiting for last news release concerning the awards Chapter 985 and members won at the Division 9 Convention to appear in the Tinker Take Off. President Pepin advised he and FTA Quirk had an interview with a staff writer on Monday, June 5, but he was unable to attend. SSgt Quirk did the interview, and he had a questionnaire to complete and return to the staff interviewer before the article was to be published.
- d. **Awards:** Mike Devenitch – On leave, no awards pending.
- e. **Treasurer's Report:** Rob Binard – Unable to attend. He sent the May 2006 Treasurer's Report with Kristi Binard. She provided a comprehensive briefing of the report on his behalf. There were no questions.
- f. **Secretary's Report:** Don Sullivan – Advised that minutes from the General Membership meeting May 11, 2006 and the Executive Council meeting June 1, 2006 were distributed via our web e-mail server. He could/would summarize for any that had not seen them, or was interested in further discussion. There being no issues, motion was made by Tim Ossinger to accept as written, seconded by

Ralph Binkley - motion carried.

- g. **Recruiting:** Sabrina Barfield – Briefed we currently have over 200 total new member recruits in the system and all are still not posted. President Pepin qualified for the Skyhigh Club as of 31 May with 101 new recruits this year, and Trustee Ossinger is now over 61. President Pepin/Kristi Binard briefed we have a couple of special recruiting opportunities; ALS at 1115 on June 14 and volunteer appreciation lunch on June 16 from 100-1200 hours. Next regular scheduled recruiting opportunity is FTAC on June 19 at 0900 hours
- h. **Reports:** Don Sullivan - Advised all reports are current. The AFSA Team Tinker for May 2006 was finalized and attached to the Executive Council meeting minutes for June 1, 2006. They have also been posted to the web site.
- i. **Airman Activities Coordinator:** Kristi Binard - Recapped the following activities: We had 7 volunteers to man aid and water stations for the March of Dimes Walk America event on May 6 (approx. \$34,000 was raised). Also, She and Mike Crawford initiated an OU Children's Hospital Toy Drive for their toy cart during May. \$1700.00 worth of toys were collected and donated. AAC Binard is seeking volunteers for The RMHC (Ronald McDonald House for Children) of OKC Lighthouse Triathlon. The event is scheduled for August 6 and over 100 volunteers are needed (we have 20 volunteers to date). Chief Ossinger gave Kristi a contact at St. Ann's Veteran's Home and she called. They hold a Senior's Dance every last Thursday of the month and would appreciate volunteers. There are 186 residents, about 85% women and 15% men. Active duty volunteers are requested to wear class A blues because aging veterans appreciate the service of today's younger force. Contact Kristi for more

7. **Old Business:**

- a. **Chapter Polo Shirts.** Mike Devenitch advised we still have ample chapter polo shirts for sale at a reduced price of \$15.00. **Item Open.**

- d. **Volunteer Appreciation Lunch.** AAC Kristi Binard asked the chapter to support a luncheon to show our appreciation of the some 70 people that volunteer to support our projects. It was approved not to exceed \$200.00 and is scheduled for June 16, 2006 from 1100-1200 in Heritage at the Med. Group. Pizza, chips and pop will be served. This event will also provide a recruiting opportunity. **Item Open**
- e. **2007 Division 9 Annual Convention.** President Pepin stated he received an e-mail from Div. 9 President that we will have a joint convention with Division 8 hosting. The location will be Ramada Inn, St. Joseph, MO. This was the preferred option voted on by the membership at

the 2006 Division 9 Annual Convention in Minot, ND. The dates are not decided. The last weekend in April and mid-June 2007 are the dates being looked at. You will be informed as information becomes available. **Item Closed**

- f. **Choctaw High School AFJROTC.** President Pepin read a Thank You Letter the chapter received for our support of their annual awards program. **Item Closed**

8. **New Business:**

- a. **International Convention.** President Pepin briefed the convention is scheduled for August 13-17, 2006 at Reno, Nevada. The chapter budgeted for a full page program ad, which this year will cost \$215.00 and is due by June 1st. The Council likes the ad used for the Division Convention program, just changing references to International. President Pepin will send it and an alternate to the Exec. Council for comments/input. VP Devenitch reminded all that these conventions are informative and fun. Last year in Dallas, we had SecDef Rumsfeld as a speaker and plenty of well named entertainment. Item Open
- b. **VP of the Tinker POW/MIA Committee Annual Golf Tournament.** President Pepin advised he received an e-mail this morning requesting our usual support of sponsoring a hole for \$100.00. Mike Devenitch motioned we do so, Chief O seconded, motion carried. Item Closed.
- c. **OU Children's Medical Center Toy Collection Drive.** Initially reported on under the Airman Activities Coordinator's report above. An e-mail has been sent through our mailing list server. POC Mike Crawford in the Med Group said he is already getting heaps of e-mail from all across the base. Collections boxes will be placed at various locations, and who/how to deliver to the medical center will be determined. Mike briefed they have room at the Med Group to store collected items. He and President Pepin will coordinate transportation to deliver the goods. Item Open.

- d. **BX Recruiting Booth.** President Pepin and Mike Devenitch secured a recruiting booth at the BX for May 15, 2006 from 10:00 – 4:00 PM. They further briefed the membership how to approach and solicit potential members. Pepin’s personal goal is 45 new members. President Pepin also reminded that he briefed 44 students at ALS on May 9, and we have a briefing scheduled for the only FTAC class of the month Friday, May 12, at 1345 hours. Item Open.
- e. **Play Station Tournament.** President Pepin briefed that TSgt Hodges is interested in having a Play Station Madden Football Tournament for AFSA and Non-AFSA members in hopes of soliciting membership. TSgt Hodges indicated he would be the POC for this and anticipates holding it in August/September 2006, more to come. Item Open
