4. Reports:

- **A. Secretary's Report:** Secretary Latoya Irving reported that the Oct GM Minutes and Nov EC Minutes were distributed list server and posted to our website http://afsa985.org. Motion to accept, Treasurer Mary Rokitka, 2nd by Trustee Richard Porter, motion passed.
- **B.** Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Mary Rokitka provided a comprehensive briefing of the Oct 2013 Treasurer's Report. Motion to accept, Trustee Richard Porter, 2nd by Secretary Latoya Irving, motion passed.
- **C. Team Tinker/Quarterly**: Trustee Don Sullivan briefed that the October AFSA Team Tinker was sent out via our list server early this morning.
- **D.** Legislative: President Terry Turner briefed November legislative report. Discussion ensued on DoD initiative to scan ID cards at the commissary and writing letters via Capwiz.
- **E.** Activities and Programs: President Terry stated that Vice President Mike Mooney is current researching the Christmas card planning party TBD 2013. Outdoor Rec will provide the supplies. The date will be announced soon.

- G. Membership: President Terry Turner briefed on behalf of Vice President Mike Mooney and stated
 - **1. New Members**: VP Michael Mooney reported a membership summary for October 2013 as follow: 19 new members recruited resulting in a total of 190 new members recruited year-to-date from 11 different recruiters; and a total strength of 1,913 total members (1814 active and 97 lapsed)
 - 2. Recruiting Opportunities:
 - a. Membership Drives: TBD
 - 3. Renewal/Retentions: 2 members retained this month, 28 YTD from 6 retainers.
 - **4. Lapsed Member Roster:** Reported we have 94 of 97 members on the lapsed roster contacted via email for a 97% contact rate.
 - **5. Bad Address List:** President Terry Turner reported advised 31 members are on the Bad Address Listing (BAL), VP Michael Mooney.
 - **6.** Year to date Skyhigher is President Terry Turner and no Highfliers thus far.
- **H. Communications:** Trustee Don Sullivan reports that the May Aug 2013 Thunderbird News was posted October 10th to our website and available for download. The Sep-Dec preparation is underway. If you have an article to submit, please send to Don Sullivan ddsullivan@cox.net.
- **I. Webmaster/Content**: We had 1,605 unique visitors and a total of 4,524 list server subscribers to our web site in October. Total unique visitors for 2013 YTD are 12,319.

2. Old Business

- **A.** Crooked Oaks AFJROTC. President Terry Turner reported the chapter is still collecting items, so please bring it what you can! This means ABU's, blue's, service dress, and physical training gear. (Item Open).
- **B.** Presidential Volunteer Service Award (PVSA). Chapter 985 was accepted as a certifying organization. Our volunteers need to register at www.presidentialserviceawards.gov and use Record of Service Key BHH-51436 to track volunteer activities. Once hourly milestones are reached, volunteer will be recognized at appropriate time with letter from President, certificate, and lapel pin according to achievement level. Volunteers need to log in to track volunteer hours for the Chapter. Keep tracking volunteer hours; the Chapter will report them at the end of the year. President Terry Turner appointed Trustee Rachael Long to identify and log volunteer hours for chapter members. Volunteer hours need to be input NLT 31 Dec 2013. All members are current as of 10 Oct 2013. (Item Open).

- **C.** Chapter Education Grants: President Terry Turner emailed announcement via our list server; resent with new deadline date of December 6, 2013. (Item Open).
- **D.** Tulsa Quarterly General Membership Meeting (Date, Time, Place, Etc): President Terry Turner previously proposed to host meeting in Tulsa in November. ANG (Retired) CMSgt Gary Lanham is our POC in Tulsa and Trustee Richard Porter is POC for the chapter. Chief Lanham coordinated with the Tulsa ANG Command CMSgt and a meeting date of December 7, 2013 was established for the meeting during their Family Day. Chief Gary Lanham arranged for an AFSA table and briefing times for the enlisted leadership. (Item Open).
- **E. Gift Wrap:** Approval has been obtained from BX, 72ABW/FSS and SJA for month-long fundraiser from day after Thanksgiving to Christmas Eve. More will be announced. DJ Hatton will be the POC. All council members are expected to be involved. DJ Hatton will be the POC. - **H. AFSA APP**: Div 3 President Lutzen emailed that the AFSA app is now available on Google; and also an Apple app. President Terry Turner sent an announcement of these features and the links to download via our list server. (**Item Open**).
 - **I.** The 2nd Annual Midwest City Vet Parade was held 11 Nov 2013, President Terry Turner briefed that Chapter 985 had a total team of 14 volunteers (11 adults and 3 children) participate in this year's parade. - **B.** Volunteer opportunities, A Christmas dinner event, and weekly Sunday meal volunteer opportunity is available. Great way to get involved, and serve the community. Further information will be sent to President Terry Turner for further distribution. (**Item Open**).
- C. Inola AFJROTC (near Tulsa): Funding requested to support projects for the cadets, such as

marksmanship team, etc. Trustee Don Sullivan motioned at the Nov. Executive Council (EC) meeting to donate \$100, 2nd by Trustee Brian Brewer, motion carried. (**Item Closed**).

- **D. Mid-Del Food Pantry:** Trustee Don Sullivan motioned at the Nov. Executive Council (EC) meeting to donate \$100.00 to the Mid-Del Food Pantry and \$100 to the OKC Regional Food Bank to help feed the needy during the holidays. 2nd by, AAC Shelby Platt, motioned carried. He will deliver the check tomorrow along with his and wife Grace's matching donation. (**Item Closed**)
- **E.** Charter T-shirts: President Terry Turner explained at the Nov. Executive Council (EC) meeting that chapter t-shirts are needed to identify our volunteers at some functions. Trustee, Brian Brewer motioned up to \$300 for the t-shirts, 2nd by, Trustee Derick Heflin, motioned carried. (**Item Open**).
- **F.** Compton's Thank you Card: The chapter received a card from Eddie and Joanne Compton thanking the members for years of service, support and the retirement attendance/gifts. The Memories plaque and AFSA coasters presented at his retirement ceremony by President Terry Turner, VP Michael Mooney and Trustee Don Sullivan are prominently displayed in his man-cave. - **G. Military Spouses Protocol Dinner:** President Terry Turner solicited an email vote of the Executive Council to fund up to \$300.00 (one time) for printing the training booklet for the Military Spouses Traditions and Protocol Dinner. Each military spouse attendee will receive booklet on the do's and don'ts of military functions (changes of commands, awards and promotion ceremonies, retirements, Dining-outs, etc.). For example: Volunteers will receive hands on training how to set a formal military dinner table without being overwhelmed. These booklets are 48-50 pages with detailed information that can be used for a lifetime by the military spouse. The Tinker Top 3 shared the expenses last year and may co-sponsor again. The vote to support was approved on November 13, 2013. (**Item Open**).
- **H. Home Away from Home:** Lt Col Vernon Conaway, Deputy Commander 552 Operations Group, briefed the membership about the new Tinker Home Away from Home Program. This program offers young Airmen a safe haven to relax, have fun and unwind from the daily rigors on an Active Air Force Base.
